1. TQ Budget

- 2018-19 budget discussion
- Iowa Core planned expenditures will still need to be applied as curriculum teams complete their work
- HRS Summit
 - i. Offered to all building principals and encouraged to take a different team than last time and the building administrator must
 - ii. Working to reduce the costs impacted to TQ by block hotel and block registrations

2. Course Approval

- Co-teaching: Partners in Instruction and Learning – 2/5/19 APPROVED online vote
- Will work to get this up yet this spring

3. Professional Learning

- Marzano – NASOT
 - i. Four dates for registrations – and registrations are very active
 - ii. Working to cross check those are still needing to take it
 - iii. If already completed then no repeat is required
 - iv. All new teachers are required to complete during new teacher preservice
- Mentors for new instructors – who will be the one that will be determining who is qualified to be a teacher; who will be determined as a “mentor” ; working on developing a course “to teach a course” and how to facilitate adults (using Marzano materials).
- Course evaluation no longer exists and possibly need to have one developed by charter committee – same evaluation tool for every course; will communicate with R Rydstrom to add to charter committee meetings
