

Teacher Quality Committee Meeting

January 22, 2018 ELSC Metro Room

TQ Budget:

- Review of carry-over and new allocation for 2017-18
- Clarification on 'Temporary Assignment expenditures' – taking classes, teachers leading classes, Marzano course stipend payments from Summer training
- Clarification on 'Purchase of Instructional Services' – paying for vendors who deliver PD (Marzano, etc)
- Still working on SIP school plans/summer work
 - After BLT's complete the webinar and data on HRS Level 1 is compiled, they will determine the action plan. SIP work would still happen over the summer but may not happen in June
 - Would there be opportunity to have the BLT get together to have PD on HRS tools/framework?
 - Many schools will fall short of 1.4 on the HRS Framework – PLC. How will that support be delivered?
- Marzano New Art and Science of Teaching (NASOT) training – 3 summer trainings 6/7-8, 7/17-18, 8/7-8 and approximately 200+ have already registered. A goal is to get 500-600 registered to take it during the summer.
 - Provide a list of those that are registered to school principals to encourage participation.
 - Goal is 100% of teachers participate before the fall of 2019.
 - There is also a 1 day overview to new teachers during pre-service— if they receive a contract before June.
 - Teachers will be paid for the Marzano New Art and Science of Teaching (NASOT) professional learning, 13 total contact hours at \$18/hr (\$22/hour includes stipend + benefit).
 - Human Resources will share information about the summer training with new hires when they are onboarded.

Professional Learning

- Possibilities – include PLC Institute and HRS Summit – what options might be available to attend HRS and not PLC?
 - Eric Christenson will get a list of those that have attended PLC
 - We will need to identify a designated structure to bring the PD back and scale to rest of school staff.
 - We have begun using a New software tool on correlative data – FAST February data will be first to use the tool.

Course Approvals

- Course Proposal System – February 15th is the deadline
 - Data on number of courses & those registered to attend will be shared at next meeting
 - We have had more courses offered in this semester than any other year.
