Acceptable Materials

- **Cardboard Boxes**
- **Magazines / Catalogs / Phone Books**
- **Newspapers and Inserts**
- **Office Paper (Shredded / Unshredded)**
All White, Colored and Coated Papers
Brochures and Pamphlets
Correspondence Papers (Letterhead, Direct Mail Pieces and Advertising)
Envelopes (With Plastic Windows or Labels)
Folders (Manila, Coated, or Colored)
Manuals with Glued Bindings
Paper from Legal Pads, Steno Note Pads
Posters / Receipts
Scratch, Message, and Memo Pads / Self-Adhesive Notes
Soft-Covered Books / Paperback Books
- **Boxboard / Chipboard / Brown Paper Bags**
Milk Cartons / Cereal Boxes
Frozen Food Boxes / Pop Boxes
- **Plastic Containers #1 through #7 (Except Styrofoam)**
Plastic Bottles
Plastic Food Containers, Yogurt Containers (Rinsed Out)
- **Plastic Silverware**
- **Aluminum Beverage Containers**
- **Steel Food and Beverage Containers**
Soup and Food Tin Cans

Non-Acceptable Materials

- **No Glass Containers or Styrofoam**
Including Cups/ Plates, Packaging Peanuts, and Other Packaging Materials
- **Plastic Products with Food Contaminates**
Including, Food Containers, and Straws
- **Wax Paper Containers**
- **Bath and Kitchen Tissue papers**
- **Grocery Sacks, Plastic Food Baggies, Plastic, and Foil Packaging, Shrink Wrap**

Other Unacceptable Materials

- **Belts and All Clothing**
- **Ceramics / Clay Flower Pots**
- **Construction Paper**
- **Three Ring Binders (metal ring)**
- **Electronic Waste, Small Components, and Computers**
- **Food Waste**
- **Glass Bottles, Light Bulbs**
- **Other Metals of Variety**
- **Pop or Water Bottle Caps**
- **Ribbons, Bows, & Rope**
- **Rubber Hoses / Tires**
- **Sanitary Items**
- **"Sharps", such as Hypodermic Needles**
- **Wire / Hangers**
- **"Wood" of Any Kind**
