	Volunteers Needed	Description
At school for:		
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rock 'n Read	Once a week our volunteers read to a child or a small group of children.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Field Trips	Help supervise children during field trips with your child's class. Adults and older children only please.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Helping in the Classroom	Helping children with reading, math, spelling, etc. Helping teacher with projects and/or class parties. Time & schedule to be negotiated with teacher.
<input type="checkbox"/>	America Reads	A one-day national event to read to a classroom for 20 to 30 minutes.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Library help	Help shelving books, organizing, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Laminating help	Laminating items once or twice a week for the school.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Field Day (usually end of May)	Help supervise outdoor games/activities played by different classes throughout the morning.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hearing Screening Help	Escort students to and from their classrooms. Time & schedule set by the health secretary.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Brown Envelope Help	Sort items for brown envelope distribution on Weds.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Maintain & update bulletin boards	1-2 hours per week
<input type="checkbox"/>	Help in a Pinch	Can help out at the last minute!
<input type="checkbox"/>	Extra school help	Helping with extra volunteer opportunities that arise throughout the year!
