The rue Soufflot is a short street that runs from the Luxembourg Gardens to the Pantheon. It is not surprising that Marvin Cone, who enjoyed painting in the Luxembourg Gardens, would also paint a few works depicting the area immediately around the Gardens. On August 2, 1920, Cone's diary entry reads: "Painted in the morning—rue Sufflot [sic] looking up toward Pantheon."
