Grant's Expected Outcomes:

The number of students proficient on the End-of-Year ELA Assessment will increase by 5%.

100% of students will be proficient on Math Priority Standards by May 2017.

Decrease the overall number of office referrals by 30%, from May 2016 to May 2017

Decrease the number of students in subgroups receiving office referrals from one month to the next.
