Wright Vision

The Wright Community learns in a student centered environment where relationships are valued.

Wright Teacher Culture

Wright staff will focus on Teaching for Learner Differences each day. We will continue our observation/co-planning 6 week cycle to include the focus areas of differentiation, clear purpose statements, and data driven instruction.

Teachers will:

- Consistently plan for instruction across all areas
- Participate in professional learning of focus areas
- Differentiate within classrooms

PLC Teams will:

- Record team minutes
- complete ASW Reading, Priority Standard Checks & District Core Math Assessments
- have action steps for instruction identified on ASW form
- Identify non-proficient students & create targeted small group lessons based on ASW needs
- Disaggregate data and analyze subgroup information

**Focus #1: Adults at Wright Elementary will implement small groups in reading and math based on data (pre/post test and formative assessments).**

Action Steps:

Professional learning in backwards/lesson planning, instructional strategies and scaffolding.

- Academic vocabulary
- Test taking strategies
- Comprehension strategies

- RUCKUS
- Data will be placed in an Excel sheet within one week to be used for grouping and student feedback
- Teachers will delve into diagnostic data for students using :
  - F & P
  - QPS
  - Number sense Math screeners
- Unit and Weekly Lesson plans will be completed each week
- Purpose statements will be evident for each small group.
- BLT will look at data collection informally every 6 weeks
- Staff will use an established protocol for analyzing and disaggregating data (ASW)
- Teachers will provide a focus/plan for observations/co-planning
- Principal & IDS will conduct observations & co-planning meetings.

Focus #2: Adults at Wright Elementary School will participate in adult collaboration.

#### Action Steps:

- PLC's including GLT, title and special ed will meet once a month during a scheduled prep time (AM and PM alternating meeting times)
- GLT's will meet once a week at a time to be determined.
- Agendas will be available one week prior to monthly meeting.
- Teachers will provide a focus/plan for observations/co-planning
- Principal & IDS will conduct observations & co-planning meetings.
- PD participation: structuring small groups, independent/group work including technology and extensions

#### Action Steps:

- Behavior expectations posted, taught, and reinforced
- Implement behavior passports
- Morning greeting to each student everyday
- Implement Community Circle within a common, designated block of time
